VVA's Veterans Agent Orange Initiative is a humanitarian, veteran-to-veteran effort to document Agent Orange exposure (particularly from hand and truck spraying of bases) and to define likely hot spots of dangerously high dioxin levels on former U.S. and ARVN bases in Vietnam, Laos, and Cambodia.

Personal anecdotes; base maps (printed or hand drawn); photos showing Agent Orange drums, tanks, spraying, and incidents.
