SUBJECT: VA Voluntary Service (VAVS) Appointments

Individuals who serve on local VA facility VAVS committees on behalf of VVA do not represent chapters and/or state councils; they in fact represent the national organization, and must be so certified in writing by a national representative as per VA policy. When recommending an individual to be a VAVS Representative (rep) or VAVS Deputy Representative (dep), the following information must be provided for each appointment:

- 1. Name of VA facility VAVS committee (e.g. Cleveland, OH VAMC)
- 2. Name of Chief of Voluntary Services Officer, address, and email address.
- 3. Full legal name of nominee (i.e. not a nickname)
- 4. Nominee's compete mailing address
- 5. Nominee's full telephone number
- 6. Appointment position (i.e. rep or dep)
- 7. Is the nominee replacing an appointee of record? If so, please identify (e.g. John Doe to replace John Smith), and include the reason for the change (e.g. appointee of record relocated)
- 8. Is nominee already enrolled as a Regularly Scheduled (RS) volunteer?
