VVA CHAPTER TRANSMITTAL INFORMATION

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- Membership is open to veterans of the United States Armed Forces who served on active duty for other than training purposes.
 - In-Country eligibility: February 28, 1961 – May 7, 1975
 - Any duty location eligibility: August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975
- Veterans of the National Guard or Reserve components must have been called to Federal active duty to be eligible for membership.

PROOF OF SERVICE:

- The **DD-214** is the preferred documentation for membership eligibility.
- Discharge certificates, orders, and awards **may** be accepted if the **DD-214** is unavailable. (If the **DD-214** is unavailable, a Standard form **SF-180** may be used to obtain the **DD-214**)
- Proof of eligibility must be submitted with all new applications for membership.

INCARCERATED VETERANS (IVI):

- All incarcerated veteran applications for membership must include the inmate's incarcerated ID number. *WE WILL NOT PROCESS AN APPLICATION WITHOUT THE ID NUMBER.*
- Dues for incarcerated veteran in the following states are \$1 and must be renewed each year:
 - Florida
 - Illinois
 - Missouri
 - New York
 - Ohio
 - Virginia
 - Wisconsin
- Dues for incarcerated veterans in the remaining states are waived. The term of membership in these states is "duration of confinement". (DOC)
