VIETNAM VETERANS OF AMERICA JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) MEDAL PROGRAM

PURPOSE:

- 1. To honor and recognize students enrolled in high school JROTC programs for their leader ship, community service, academic achievements, and successes.
- 2. To strengthen the legacy of Vietnam Veterans of America by bringing attention to the honorable service to country and community by Vietnam veterans.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- 1. Cadet exemplifies core values of the Vietnam Veterans of America: Advocacy, Meaningful Achievement, Integrity, Compassion, Camaraderie.
- 2. Cadet must have completed second year of JROTC at end of current school year.
- 3. Cadet is in the upper 25 percent of his/her class academically and in JROTC achievements.

GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES:

- The number of medals presented each year is determined by the JROTC unit commanders and, if they choose, the participating local VVA Chapter.
- There is no limit to the number of medals that may be awarded each year.
- There is no set deadline for requesting medal & ribbon sets; they may be presented at
 any point in the year. To ensure timely delivery, submit your requests two weeks prior
 to your scheduled ceremony. Cost is \$15/medal & ribbon set. Shipping costs are
 covered by VVA national office.

- VVA Chapters are responsible for contacting their local schools with JROTC units to
 explain the program and to present award(s) to the selected cadet(s) at a ceremony of
 the school's choosing.
- VVA Chapters are responsible for purchasing the medals for their local schools.

JROTC UNITS WITHOUT AN AFFILIATED VVA LOCAL CHAPTER

- JROTC units in communities without a VVA chapter may request medal & ribbon sets directly and may also present the awards yourself.
- In this case, the JROTC Unit is responsible for purchasing the medals and ribbons for their cadet(s).
